

#### Dear Friends of Israel,

s was almost expected after four consecutive elections, Benjamin Netanyahu failed to form a government within the available 28 days. This time, he was unable to persuade one of the smaller parties to join the government, or to talk individuals into switching sides. This shows how the fronts have definitely hardened. Netanyahu's once almost magical power of persuasion appears to have evaporated. It seems that nobody believes his promises and assurances any longer.

He had tried to form a government by all available means. To reach his goal, he was ready to break with long-established taboos. Even before the elections, he was courting the Arabs as potential partners. Yet in the past, he had

been the one to warn the Israeli public that the left-wing government would be willing to strike a deal with anti-Zionist and terrorist-friendly Arabs. Actually, he would now have needed them to put together a government. But the Arabs were not to be convinced with vague promises. In addition, the newly founded ultra-Right party of Smotrich was against this plan, even though in the beginning they had received strong support from Netanyahu.

Thus, by the end of the four-week term, all options for forming a government were blocked to Netanyahu. The only thing he achieved, ironically, was to legitimize the Arabs as possible coalition partners. In fact, this is something the opposition parties


will actually have to rely on now, if they want to succeed in establishing a government. And Netanyahu will not be able to blame them, because he himself made the rapprochement with the Arab parties "acceptable." As a last desperate effort to stay in the running, Netanyahu wanted to change the law to the effect that the prime minister would from now on be elected directly by the people. This attempt, so lastminute and so obviously self-serving, naturally found no support. It is doubtful in any case whether such a move would have changed anything about the deadlocked situation.

Now, the Netanyahu opposition, led by Yair Lapid, received the mandate by the president to form a government. Whether he will succeed is, of course, questionable as well, because the diversity of the parties in this camp is even greater. Basically, the only thing uniting them is opposition to Netanyahu. Whether this will be enough to unite them into an effective government remains to be seen. It should be remembered, however, that op-

position to Netanyahu has grown over the years. The founders and leaders of four of the opposition parties have served in governments under Netanyahu. Their experiences from those times have turned them into staunch opponents of Netanyahu, even though some of them are politically and ideologically actually very close to Netanyahu's Likud party.

Therefore, it can be assumed that the current political crisis in Israel is not so much due to political or ideological factors, but rather personal objections. The opposition's immediate goal is clear: Netanyahu has to go. The only ideology that can help in this situation is, above all, the principle of national unity. The government to be formed must be one of national unity. For Israel's benefit, one can only hope that this will be accomplished—so that Israel will have an administration that pursues not division, but unity. With this hope, and looking up to Him who holds everything in His hands, greetings and Shalom.

aments are always melancholy. They are sung when our spirits have reached rock bottom. They are funeral dirges, wails; there is something mournful about them (vv. 1, 14).

This song laments the ruin of the Davidic dynasty. Everything had started off so well: David's appointment as king, the promises about him, his home and kingship. Then David's praises, his psalms...just to end like this! We can fall so far when we leave the Lord, desiring to go our own way. Looking at global political developments, and developments in Christianity or the church today, we could also strike up a lament.

### Complaint Against Those Responsible

"Moreover take thou up a lamentation for the princes of Israel" (v. 1). First, the people responsible are addressed. The "princes" are the rulers of Israel. This includes both the kings and the priests (those who hold both political and religious power). They bore

the primary responsibility, because they had brought the people to this point. Some oppressed the people, while others tolerated sin and were involved in it themselves. Everyone who bears responsibility (be it educational, political, or religious) has a special accountability: "For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall much be required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more" (Luke 12:48b).

This lament is told in the form of a parable, with varied imagery. It begins with the comparison, "And say, What is thy mother? A lioness: she lay down among lions, she nourished her whelps among young lions" (Ezek 19:2). The mother lioness stands for Judah, as well as for Israel as a whole. This is made clear by various passages in the Bible (Gen 49:9; Num 24:9; Mic 5:8). Israel camped among lions as a lioness. The lioness raised her cubs as the other lions did (namely, godless). Israel had assimilated itself to the peoples. It wanted to be like

the other nations, and eventually it was no different from them.

This theme continues in chapter 20: "And that which cometh into vour mind shall not be at all, that ye say, We will be as the heathen, as the families of the countries, to serve wood and stone" (v. 32). God had directly chosen, instructed, and enlightened this people in such an exceptional manner. They had been the only people in the world to receive the living Word of God. They were called to be the salvation of the world. And now they were adopting the position, "We want to be like the heathens."

In his book *The World of Yesterday*, Jewish Austrian author Stefan Zweig (1881–1942) writes: "Adapting themselves to the milieu

of the people or country where they live is not only an external protective measure for the Jews, but a deep internal desire. Their longing for a homeland, for rest, for security, for friendliness, urges them to attach themselves passionately to the culture of the world around them."

Generally speaking, today's Christianity is headed in the same direction. Today's "Christian" Western world no longer wants to be Christian, but pagan. It's trying to break away from its Christian roots with a vengeance, and to adapt. Even the church itself is becoming progressively more unchristian. Instead of bringing God's offer of love to the world, it's resembling the world and its sins.

This example illustrates how far we've come in the West, once dominated by Christianity. In 2014, Munich, Germany's official city portal advertised their family pass, which offers attractive offers and discounts for families. The graphics show two men with a child, and two women with two children. The conventional family (father, mother, and children) was nowhere to be seen!

Both the Apostle Paul and the Apostle Peter warn against

becoming like the world, and call for a change of heart through sanctification. Paul writes, "And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God" (Rom 12:2). Peter writes, "As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance: But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation" (1 Pet 1:14-15).

When we begin to assimilate, we simultaneously begin to stray. This always ends in disaster. I read somewhere that snake venom is around 90% proteins. Proteins are one of the most important building blocks of human nutrition, and are used for the constant replacement of

our cells. Even so, it wouldn't occur to anyone to take snake venom for nourishment; the poison in it is much stronger, and the person would inevitably die. The "poison" of this world is the same. We do have to live and work in this world, but at the same time, we must be careful not to be poisoned by it.

#### As You Sow, So Shall You Reap

"And she brought up one of her whelps: it became a young lion, and it learned to catch the prey; it devoured men. The nations also heard of him; he was taken in their pit, and they brought him with chains unto the land of Egypt" (Ezek 19:3-4). Israel, which had become godless, and its kings raised their children according to the norms of the nations; according to the world's guidelines, and no longer according to the Word of God. The result was just what you'd expect.

The young lion referred to here is the godless Judean king Jehoahaz. "Catching the prey" and "devouring men" is likely a reference to his tyrannical reign, in which he brought more harm than blessing to his people. In 609 BC, only three months into his reign, he was captured by the Egyptian pharaoh Necho II and brought to Riblah (northern Israel), and then later to Egypt where he died: "Jehoahaz was twenty and three years old when he began to reign; and he reigned three months Ierusalem. And his mother's name was Hamutal, the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah. And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his fathers had done. And Pharaohnechoh put him in bands at Riblah in the land of Hamath, that he might not reign in Jerusalem; and put the land to a tribute of an hundred talents.

of silver, and a talent of gold. And Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name Jehoiakim, and took Jehoahaz away: and he came to Egypt, and died there" (2 Kgs 23:31-34). That was the fate of the people to whom blessings and victory had been promised! Israel had been called to rule over nations, and now its king died in enemy territory—in the very land from which the Lord had rescued them some 800 years earlier! Israel's king had once again become the prey of the enemy from whom the Lord had delivered him. What a tragedy!

Is it possible for one—you or I—to be saved from the world by the grace of the Lord Jesus, and then later allow oneself to be reclaimed by it?

Is it possible for someone to be overcome by the world, instead of overcoming it?

Is it possible for someone to cast aside the Person that saved them from this present world (Gal 1:4), in order to follow the world again?

Is it possible for someone to spread darkness again, instead of being a light in this world?

Is it possible for someone to be tempted by people to go back into the world, instead of saving people from it?

Peter has this to say about it: "For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning" (2 Pet 2:20).

#### **Continuing Decline**

"Now when she saw that she had waited, and her hope was lost, then she took another of her whelps, and made him a young lion. And he went up and down among the lions, he became a young lion, and learned to catch the prey, and devoured men. fulness thereof, by the noise of his roaring. Then the nations set against him on every side from the provinces, and spread their net over him: he was taken in their pit. And they put him in ward in chains, and brought him to the king of Babylon: they brought him into holds, that his voice should no more be heard upon the mountains of Israel" (Ezek 19:5-9). Instead of understanding, and instead of repenting, the Lioness, Israel (Judah) raised another evil king. This is probably referring to Jehoiachin.

Jehoiachin also ruled for just three months, but it was a time of horror and destruction of his own people. It was so bad that God even used Israel's enemies to put a stop to the hardship and injustice Jehoiachin caused. This was achieved through the Babylonians under Nebuchadnezzar in 597 BC. A horrifying concept: God made use of Israel's enemies, to save the

people from King Jehoiachin's reign of terror! "So Jehoiakim slept with his fathers: and Jehoiachin his son reigned in his stead. And the king of Egypt came not again any more out of his land: for the king of Babylon had taken from the river of Egypt unto the river Euphrates all that pertained to the king of Egypt. Jehoiachin was eighteen years old when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem three months. And his mother's name was Nehushta, the daughter of Elnathan of Jerusalem. And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father had done. At that time the servants of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came up against Jerusalem, and the city was besieged. And Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came against the city, and his servants did besiege it. his mother, and his servants, and his princes, and his officers: and the king of Babylon took him in the eighth year of his reign. And he carried out thence all the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house, and cut in pieces all the vessels of gold which Solomon king of Israel had made in the temple of the LORD, as the LORD had said" (2 Kgs 24:6-13). Jehoiachin was imprisoned for 37 years, until the son of Nebuchadnezzar released him. He never returned home.

A person can fall so far! In today's terms: a rebelling Chris-

tian can bring so much misery and hardship on his own family (parents, children, siblings), but also on the church! A person can wreak so much havoc when he no longer allows himself to be controlled by the Holy Spirit, but instead by his emotions, stubbornness, and egoism! Many are affected and even pulled down with him, just because he doesn't want to pull himself together and repent. It can even get so bad that the Lord uses the people of the world to step in and stop it.

#### **Antisemitic Crimes Rose 15% in 2020**

Berlin police arrested a 53-year-old German man on suspicion of sending dozens of threatening letters to politicians, lawyers and journalists that were signed with the acronym of a neo-Nazi group, as officials warned that statistics show a disturbing rise in farright extremism across Germany.

Antisemitic crimes rose by more than 15 percent in 2020, the data showed.

Interior Minister Horst Seehofer said far-right crime rose 5.65% in 2020, accounting for more than half of all criminality categorized as "politically motivated."

"This shows again that right-wing extremism is the biggest threat for our country," Seehofer told reporters while announcing the annual statistics.

The letters were signed "NSU 2.0." A German group called the National Socialist Underground was responsible for a string of violent crimes between 1998 and 2011, including the racially motivated killings of nine men with immigrant backgrounds

srael and Greece have signed their biggest defense deal worth close to £1.2 billion (\$1.7 billion US).

Israel's Elbit Systems won the contract to establish a training center for the Hellenic Air Force.

It will supply new training aircraft as well as advanced avionic equipment to school pilots.

Israel's Defense Minister Benny Gantz said, "This cooperation agreement rests on the excellence of Israeli industry and on the strong, longstanding relations between the defense establishments of Israel and Greece."

and a police officer. The group's name was derived from the full name of the Nazi, or National Socialist, party.

German security agencies warned of the growing threat of violent far-right extremism. In July 2019, a regional politician from Chancellor Angela Merkel's party was killed by a neo-Nazi; three months later, a gunman tried to force his way into a synagogue on Yom Kippur, killing two people.

Seehofer said the new statistics reveal an ongoing increase in antisemitic crimes in Germany, which was up 15.7% in 2020 over 2019 with 2,351 total incidents—94.6% of which were committed by a far-right suspect.

Of the total, 62 were acts of violence while the majority were antisemitic hate speech and other related crimes, frequently on the internet or over social media, Seehofer said.

"This development in Germany is not only troubling, but in view of our history, deeply shameful," he said.

Moshe Kantor, president of the European Jewish Congress, said the German numbers highlight a broader issue.

"This is a wake-up call, not just for Germany, but for the whole world," he said. "These figures should ring alarm bells, because we are seeing similar trends across the Western world."

## JERUSALEM MOST POPULAR DESTINATION

erusalem is the most sought out destination for tourists visiting Israel from abroad, according to new data published by the Tourism Ministry.

Around 79% of tourists visiting Israel in 2019 (3.6 out of 4.55 million) stopped in Jerusalem to wade through the streets of the Israeli capital and the historic sites of the Old City during their tour of the Jewish state.

Before the onset of the coronavirus pandemic, Israel experienced a record year for incoming tourism in 2019, with approximately 4.55 million foreign tourists visiting the Jewish State that year—an 11% jump from 2018, injecting around NIS 23 billion into the economy.

Israel is preparing for the return of international tourism following a year-long hiatus due to the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

Floretta Mayerson is cofounder of the Mexican startup Violetta, a digital safe space where domestic violence victims can get psychological and legal assistance anytime via a chatbot.

"We have always admired the Israeli startup environment. The growth potential of questioning and rethinking our project through its lens is huge."

"The internationalism of the program is core to what we do. Our Jerusalem location was always meant to serve startups from around the world," says MassChallenge Israel Managing Director Yonit Serkin.

The MassChallenge locations in Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Texas, Mexico and Switzerland also draw applicants from outside of their geography. But not from as far afield as the Israeli branch attracts.

"Here it's truly from all corners of the world," Serkin tells ISRAEL21c.

Serkin also points out that "the incredible density of entrepreneurship here doesn't exist elsewhere. We can connect with the best minds at some 400 multinational R&D centers within an hour's drive from Jerusalem. You don't have this density of innovation professionals in any other place.

#### RESEARCH 'SWITCHES OFF' BRAIN CONNECTORS

sraeli scientists have developed a way to switch off connectors that link different parts of the brain, in an advance they say could prove key to treating neurological disorders like epilepsy.

The innovation, which relies on a light-sensitive protein from mosquitos, was reported on in the peer-reviewed journal *Neuron*. Dozens of neurobiology teams around the world are already ordering the protein and using the protocol in their own labs.

"Our new method is the first that allows scientists to increase or decrease the function of certain pathways that connect parts of the brain, or shut them off completely," Prof. Ofer Yizhar of the Weizmann Institute of Science told *The Times of Israel*.

"The ultimate aim is that this will allow us to better understand the pathways of the brain, and which of them can be targeted to treat various brain disorders."

#### California Home to 22 Israeli Tech Unicorns

"The numbers are wild," United States — Israel Business Alliance (USIBA) president Aaron Kaplowitz said in an email text message accompanying the statement.

"California continues to attract many of the best and brightest innovators in the world," he added. "We're seeing today a new generation of Israeli entrepreneurs contribute to northern California's innovation ecosystem and benefit from a deep bench of venture capitalists."

Eight Israeli-founded unicoms headquarter in San Francisco, the most of any US city behind New York, the statement said. Deel, with its office just beyond Oracle Park baseball field, is the most recent addition to the unicom



club. The payroll and compliance platform startup announced the completion of a \$156 million funding round, driving its valuation to \$1.25 billion. Deel has raised \$206 million total—all in the past 11 months.

Trailing San Francisco, Palo Alto now has seven Israeli-founded unicorns, including insurance firms Hippo, valued at \$5 billion, and Next Insurance, at \$4 billion. On March 22, Wiz closed a \$130 million round, valuing the firm at a whopping \$1.7 billion just three months after emerging from stealth.

"Silicon Valley lives by the 'move fast and break things' mantra," Kaplowitz said. "The Israelis, of course, have a word for that: chutzpah."

USIBA published research findings on the 21 Israeli-founded unicorns based in New York. Tel Aviv is the city with the most Israeli-founded unicorns in the world.

Soon after the New York report, Outbrain, a unicorn from the list, filed a confidential prospectus with the US Securities and Exchange Commission for plans to IPO. This development came a day after Israeli-founded ad software company DoubleVerify—headquartered in SoHo—closed its first day on the New York Stock Exchange up 33 percent, leading it to a market cap of \$5.3 billion, the USIBA statement said.

At the same time, intermarriage is rising rapidly, with Jews who got married in the last decade significantly more likely to be married to a non-Jew than a Jew and the rate of intermarriage increasing significantly over the previous decade.

The study demonstrated that American Jews aged 18-29 are displaying less and less attachment to the Jewish people and Jewish life.

According to the data, 40% of Jews of this cohort say they are not Jewish by religion while, rather naturally, denominational affiliation is also lower among young Jews with only 29% saying they are Reform and just 8% saying they are Conservative.

### Urban Transportation Takes to the Skies

Urban Aeronautics (UA), a leading Israeli aerospace company is revolutionizing the future of urban mobility. The company designed and is currently developing carsized aircraft that will provide safe and rapid transport via seamless city integration.

"Our vision," says Haran Ben-Eliahou, Urban Aeronautic's vice president, "is to create a vehicle for urban mobility. Everything is compact and enclosed within the vehicle to allow for safe transportation and the ability to land on any rooftop or available city corner."

Ben-Eliahou explains that the primary use cases for VTOL aircraft are providing shuttle service between airports and city centers and serving as medical air ambulances to transport accident victims. "There are many places that helicopters cannot access and with a Cityhawk, you can save

lives by arriving sooner than a regular ambulance."

Cities around the world including LA, Vancouver, Singapore, Paris, and London, are taking their first steps towards implementing this revolutionary aviation with commercial flights expected by as early as 2025.

In just five years, thousands of VTOL aircraft worldwide will be shuttling passengers from airports to city centers. The infrastructure required for these devices, suggests Ben-Eliahou, will be more of a limiting factor than the aircraft itself.

Urban Aeronautics has partnered with some of the leading names in the aerospace industry, including Boeing and Safran, the French aerospace component firm, with plans to receive FAA approval and be fully certified by 2026.

"Developing an aircraft takes time, but our plans are in place," says Ben-Eliahou. "Our extensive experience with staff who have worked for IAI and other major commercial aviation companies, giving us a strong team to execute those plans and bring it to market."

#### NEWSPAPER DISAVOWS BALFOUR DECLARATION

n an article about its "worst errors of judgment" from its 200-year history, a *Guardian* writer implied that the storied British paper's editorial support of the Balfour Declaration of 1917—the then-British foreign minister's approval of a "national home for the Jewish people" in Palestine—was a mistake.

"The *Guardian* of 1917 supported, celebrated and could even be said to have helped facilitate the Balfour declaration," editorial writer Randeep Ramesh wrote in the article.

"Whatever else can be said, Israel today is not the country the Guardian foresaw or would have wanted," he added, arguing that the Guardian's editor at the time, Charles Prestwich Scott, was ignorant about Palestinian rights.

The Balfour Declaration, in which the United Kingdom committed itself to creating a national home for Jews in lands it controlled and today comprise the territories of Israel, the Palestinian Authority and Jordan, was an important milestone for the Zionist movement.

The backbone of the IAF consisted of 25 Avia S-199s (purchased from Czechoslovakia, essentially Czechoslovak-built Messerschmitt Bf 109s) and 60 Supermarine Spitfire LF Mk IXEs, the first of which, "Israel 1" was locally assembled from British abandoned spare parts and a salvaged engine from an Egyptian Spitfire with most of the rest purchased from Czechoslovakia.

bout the name "Shit-Unger's tim." Bible Dictionary notes: "The barren valley of the Jordan above the Dead Sea, and was chosen by the prophet Joel (3:18) to denote a very dry valley...In the prophecy the springs which water this valley, and proceed from the house of Jehovah, the physical as well as spiritual blessings, which will come to [Israel] and its inhabitants in the Kingdom Age, are portrayed."

When reading chapter 3 of the prophet Joel, we realize that the whole world is involved. It is the Lord's day of judgment against those who have opposed God's elect. Verse 2a states: "I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat." Why is He doing such? Read on: "and will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel." Very clearly, a distinction is made: all the nations of the world, and "my heritage Israel." Then comes the reason for the judgment: "whom they [nations] have scattered among the nations, and parted my land."

ness, the god of this world. When we begin to realize this fact, we should immediately understand that we, as believers, belong to a different group, because we are organically connected to Israel. Thus, our calling is to identify ourselves as heavenly citizens. We are the light of the world. Philippians 2:15 instructs us: "That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world." national water corporations in every country and execute optimization based on that data, including switching off systems according to consumption, decreasing loads at data centers, directing activity during emergencies and more.


The global demand for water is expected to increase by tens of percentage points by 2030 in comparison with the present ability for an optimal supply. According to the CEO of Evolution Water, Amir Yaar, decision-makers are beginning to understand that finding solutions for increasing supply and improving productivity is important to deal with this issue.




did it to one of the least of these My brothers, you have done it to Me" (Matthew 25:34-40).
