# Dear Friends of Israel,

srael's attitude concerning Christmas has become quite Lopen and tolerant. In Hebrew is called Chag ha-Molad, "Feast of the Birth." In many stores and shopping malls there are Christmas trees. This dates back to the immigrants from Russia. In Russian, the celebration is called "Novi God," meaning New Year. So, the Christmas trees have no direct relation to Christmas, but rather to the New Year. The Russian immigrants love their traditions, even though many in Israel still don't like to see their symbols.

Like Christmas, the eight-day festival of Chanukkah is in December, even though this year it starts early, at the end of November. In Haifa, Chanukkah and Christmas have been celebrated together in December for many years. Every year, a great Christmas tree is placed in the center of town, and

the main street leading to the harbor is magnificently lit up. Next to Nazareth, Haifa has the second largest Christian minority, at about 20,000. Lighting in the city remains until mid-January, because the Orthodox Christians don't celebrate Christmas until January 6th and 7th. The Hebrew name for all of it is Chag Orim or Chag ha-Chagim, which means Feast of Lights or Festival of Festivals. If an Islamic feast happens to fall into the same time frame, the Muslims are included in the festivities.

With Haifa being the most liberal city in Israel, this festival has become the showcase for coexistence and cooperation. Many people these days take a trip to Haifa in order to see and experience all of it for themselves.

"Festival of Lights" is actually a beautiful and apt name for Christmas. When Jesus was born, He was the One who could say of Himself: "I am the light of the world." Twice Isaiah calls the Anointed One of the Lord "Light of the Nations (Gentiles)": once in Isaiah 42:6, and again in Isaiah 49:6, which reads: "It is too small a thing for you to be my servant to restore the tribes of Jacob and bring back those of Israel I have kept. I will also make you a light for the Gentiles (i.e., nations), that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth."

Thus, His first and foremost task was to bring back the tribes of Israel which had wandered far away from the right path. When Jesus said: "I was sent only to the lost sheep of Israel" (Matthew 15:24), He meant His physical presence. But His message was for the whole world, as foretold by Isaiah. Paul referred to this passage of Isaiah 49:6 and said: "We had to speak the word of God to you first. Since you reject it and do not consider yourselves worthy of eternal life, we now turn to the Gentiles. For this is what the Lord has commanded us: 'I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth" (Acts 13:46-47).

The divine hierarchy is thus: first the Jews, and then the Gentiles. When the Jews increasingly rejected Christ's salvation, Paul understood this word from Isaiah as a command of the Lord to now take the light of the Gospel to all nations, so that it would be carried to the ends of the earth.

Today, we can say that His light and His salvation have really reached the ends of the earth. Yet, as once the Jews rejected the Gospel, we can now see a similar development in our time. Salvation and the light of the Gospel is being increasingly rejected or ignored, and the word from Isaiah 60:2 is becoming more and more a reality: "For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth and gross darkness the people." Only when we follow Him, we will not "walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (John 8:12).

Wishing that His light and His salvation will be your joy and companion into the New Year, I send you warm greetings with Shalom from Israel,

It has become very dark in our world, increasingly darker in every domain—morally, ethically, politically, among the nations and in Israel: religiously, economically, and concerning climate hysteria, in which creation has been elevated to a god (Rom 1:23, 25).

E conomic collapse could lie ahead. Technologically, we're marching rapidly toward total control. The sea of peoples is restless, and the waves are breaking on all continents.

# Our humanity is downright deranged;

it's unable to distinguish between light and darkness; it's groping in the dark; it has no orientation; everything operates as if in blind chaos, confused and against itself; norms are overthrown; people stumble because there is no longer any foothold or guideline; people are clueless and hopeless. And this doesn't stop at the church door. William Booth, founder of the Salvation Army, said in his day, "The chief danger that confronts the coming century will be religion without the Holy Spirit, Christianity without Christ, forgiveness without repentance, salvation without regeneration, politics without God, heaven without hell."

Theologian Bodo Becker uses Bible verses to show how deeply we've advanced into the night.

Apostasy as a sign of the imminent end: renunciation of God and His power (2 Tim 3:4-5). Renunciation of the divine Sonship of Jesus (1 John 2:18; 4:3). Renunciation of Jesus' claim to power (2 Pet 2:1). Renunciation of Jesus' return (2 Pet 3:3-4). Renunciation of the faith (1 Tim 4:1-2; Jude 3). Renunciation of the Bible and sound doctrine (2) Tim 4:3-4). Renunciation of a holy lifestyle (2 Tim 3:1-7). Renunciation of true godliness (2 Tim 4:3-4). Renunciation of Christian morality (2 Tim 3:1-8, 13; Jude 18). Renunciation of true Christian unity (2 Pet 2:1; Jude 19). Renunciation of the fear of God (2 Pet 2:10-12). Renunciation of humility and dependence on God (Rev 3:17). Renunciation of authority (2 Tim 3:4).

A turning toward deceptive spirits and demons (1 Tim 4:1). A tendency toward unbiblical commandments (1 Tim 4:3). Turning to an immoral lifestyle (2 Tim 3:1-5; 2 Pet 2:2, 13-14; Jude 4, 18). A turning toward

fables and myths (2 Tim 4:4). Turning to numerous teachers not appointed by God (2 Tim 4:3). A tendency toward wealth and arrogance (Rev 3:17). A tendency toward irreverence and mockery (2 Tim 3:2; 2 Pet 2:10-12; 3:3; Jude 18).

It seems that we're already falling into the substantial errors Paul mentions in 2 Thessalonians 2:11. That's why we should focus on the basics, namely as those who "[know] the time, that now it is high time 1) to awake out of sleep. For now is our salvation nearer than when we believed...

2) Let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and 3) let us put on the armor of light. 4) Let

us walk honestly, as in the day, not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying. 5) But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and 6) make not provision for the flesh, to fulfill the lusts thereof" (Rom 13:11-14).

What should we do? Wake up, and come to life. The Amplified Bible translates this as, "Do this, knowing that this is a critical time. It is already the hour..." We should be awakened to action. On a trip to Egypt, I discovered the following saying along the Nile: "You can't get to the other side of a river by just standing and wistfully looking over."

Awaken to prayer. Awaken to the step you should have been taking a long time ago. Don't sleep away the chance of your life!

For what else, according to Paul, should we be awake? Submission to governing authorities, and not wasting strength on polit-

ical things we can't change anyway (vv. 1-7). Someone who is awake keeps the small things small and lets the big things be big. We need to put all of our energy behind governmental change through Jesus' return. Most of this world has been positively changed by the gospel. So, we shouldn't be identified by sin, but by God's love (vv. 8-10).

The Christian should awaken to the great theme of Jesus' return. Lonce read that the Lord's return is mentioned 1,527 times in the 992 chapters of the Old Testament, and announced 318 times in the 260 chapters of the New Testament. It was so uniquely important for God's Holy Spirit to supply this to the writers of the Bible. But the danger for all of us is to lose sight of just that; to become tired, to dream of other things, and to stop being vigilant. Someone wrote about this Bible passage: "It is peculiar and shameful that the Apostle Paul has to call on believers to arise from sleep, to look at the biblical prophetic clock, to recognize the

current time period, to throw off the works of darkness, and to put on the weapons of light. Shouldn't such warnings be redundant?"

In the part of Germany I grew up in, maypoles were a tradition. Each village had its maypole up for a certain period of time, and villages would try to steal them from each other. The village with the most poles at the end would win. Watch was kept day and night; people divided the hours in each day among themselves. Some went to steal the pole from another village, while others ensured that their own wasn't stolen.

One time, I was to keep watch. I felt wide awake. Then I grew a little sleepy. I thought that closing my eyes a little wouldn't hurt, since the slightest sound would wake me right up. Besides, it wasn't easy to silently steal a large, heavy tree trunk that had been deeply buried. Suddenly, a teammate nudged me and startled me. He asked me where the pole was. I didn't have the slightest idea,

and I was so convinced that I had been watching! It was extremely embarrassing to face all our other friends.

What does a watchman need to do? He must take his assignment, his mission, seriously. He should honor his employer and be loyal to him. He must be proficient in the use of his eyes, ears, and weapons. To apply this to ourselves, this means he must know the Bible. He should be in constant radio contact with his superior, and remain in communication. We reflect this in prayer and in the fellowship of the Holy Spirit. A watchman must also be

able to react quickly and appropriately. He must not become distracted.

Why has missionary zeal been lost, personally and in the church? Or the desire to glorify Jesus with our whole lives and everything we have? Why have our hearts

become filled with things that are worthless and ephemeral, while the things that are spiritually valuable are relegated to the furthest corner? We're no longer awake! We're no longer Spirit-filled. The Spirit of God awakens, brings light, sets priorities, exalts and glorifies Jesus, is jealous for God's cause, and convicts. Catholic radio preacher Peter Lippert said in his day, "The world isn't ignited with burning candles, but with burning hearts." Someone else said, "Only those who are awake can wake others "

of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light" (Rom 13:12). Once the alarm clock has rung, you get changed. Sleepwear is removed, and day clothes are put on.

Fritz Binde once said, "Christians don't wear masks." Christians must be real. There can't be any untruthfulness, hypocrisy, ambiguity, or shadowy existence. The works of darkness should be discarded, and the weapons of light put on. The works of darkness are works that concern the world, which is controlled by the prince of darkness: every kind of sin, self-ishness, cheating, greed, abuse, hatred, lies, war, secrecy, deception, etc.

**Detest evil, and hold fast to good (Rom 12:9b).** Keep away from every kind of evil (1 Thess 5:22). Become righteously sober and do not sin (1 Cor 15:34). "Walk as children of light" (Eph 5:8b).

The weapons of light are the essence of Jesus Christ: being clothed in the Word of God, in love, in faith, in anticipation of the Lord's return, employing the

gifts of grace, being of the same mind and direction toward the goal. We can only be true light if we fight the works of darkness in our lives. And that's only possible with the weapons of light. The Holy Spirit deliberately chose this expression. The works of darkness can only be truly defeated with the weapons of light. We are in a battle.

The weapon of love defeats the works of hate. Some time ago, I read the biography of Richard Wurmbrand and his wife Sabina (*Tortured for Christ*, by The Voice of the Martyrs). It made a lasting impression on me. The couple chose to love in an environment of hate; the hardest people were struck by this weapon, turning them into staunch believers.

The weapon of the Holy Spirit—the Word of God—defeats the work of lies, smashes doubt and hopelessness (see the armor of God in Ephesians 6). When the communists entered the Wurmbrands' house, they were looking for an excuse to arrest

them. So they asked Sabina about hidden weapons. She answered, "This is the only weapon we have in the house," and she showed them her Bible. After having resisted communist propaganda for years in prison, Richard Wurmbrand wrote: "There is only one method of resistance to brainwashing. This is 'heartwashing.' If the heart is cleansed by the love of Jesus Christ, and if the heart loves Him, one can resist all tortures. Our head always obeys our heart, and when Iesus Christ cleanses our heart, the head will inevitably follow. 'Of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh' (Luke 6:45)." Wurmbrand said of the communists: "I learned from them. As they allowed no place for Jesus in their hearts, I decided I would leave not the smallest place for Satan in mine."

We should follow the day's instructions: "Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chamber-

ing and wantonness, not in strife and envying. But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfill the lusts thereof" (Rom 13:13-14).

After waking up and getting changed, you leave the house: "Walk honestly, as in the day." I read that it can also be translated this way: "Go like those who walk in the day." The Greek word euschemon means "gracefully" or "of good standing." Walk as those who walk in the ways of Christ with good standing. A citizen of heaven lives in the day, in the sunlight. Everything is visible there; he has a good and pure testimony. There is nothing hidden, secret, that should be concealed. Paul lists six negative things that are mentioned in pairs:

"Not in rioting (orgies) and drunkenness." These are signs of lacking self-control and discipline. Everything you see is blurred. A clear view, and a firm and certain step toward the goal are lacking. "Not in chambering (sexual immorality) and wantonness (sensuality)." It's stressful to see that adultery and divorce are increasing among Christians. This is often because a line has been crossed into the world, into darkness, and we are dwelling in the shadow area. From there, it's easy to take the next step into something worse.

"Not in strife and envying." James describes quarreling and jealousy as wisdom from belowfrom the devil (James 3:14-17). Someone once noted that jealousy is the jaundice of the soul. A friend of mine wrote: "A church's atmosphere is profoundly defined by what each individual thinks and says about the others. Even if we don't utter a single word from our lips, our negative attitudes toward others are a low blow to a wound that, if there is no cleansing, can disrupt and destroy an entire church. Conversely, benevolent thoughts and speech about each other is a divine radiance, which in turn invigorates the whole church. We have a lot of energy in our hands that can be used for life or for apathy in a church [...] We can't see into another's heart; only the Lord can do that. He will reveal the hidden motivations and decisions of the heart; why various things happened, and then each will receive his praise from God."

# And so we're called to put on the Lord

Jesus. Yes, but Christ already lives in us! So, what does the Apostle Paul mean? We should put on the nature and the mind of our Lord. God's goal is for us to be of the same mind that Christ Jesus was (Phil 2:5). We should claim by faith what He has accomplished for us. "But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption" (1 Cor 1:30). "Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them" (Heb 7:25). This leaves nothing to be desired. We should be putting on the promises that God offers us in Christ. As some-

one once said, "Jesus fulfilled the condition for God to love you unconditionally."

"Make not provision for the flesh, to fulfill the lusts thereof." This could also be translated as, "Don't do anything else that arouses your desires!" The fleshly mind is the enemy of everything spiritual. We're in the midst of the struggle between spirit and flesh (Gal 5:17). Therefore, it's important to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Pet 3:18).

"For now is our salvation nearer than when we believed...

The day is at hand." So at the end of the day, it's all about the living hope of our future salvation. We're assured of this by a divine guarantee.

Jesus is coming! He is bringing us into His kingdom. We share in

His kingdom. We are children of God, and joint heirs with Christ, His body. A life with God the Father and His Son, in incredible and indescribable beauty and perfection, is awaiting us! Every earthly quality, no matter how beautiful, fades into insignificance. That's a strong motivation to do justice to these things in our lives. Because of His love for us and because of our love for Him, we want to accept the hope He offers. We need to awaken to this—now! Yes, don't just stand on the riverbank...

# **Scorpion Invasion**

Storms and flooding in the southern Egyptian province of Aswan killed three people and led to 503 others being stung by scorpions, officials said.



Scorpions are regularly washed into Egypt's streets by heavy rain and take refuge in houses AFP VIA GETTY IMAGES

State media initially attributed the deaths to scorpions forced into streets and homes by the rainwater.

But the health ministry later said that all of those stung were treated with anti-venom in hospital and survived.

The three fatalities were soldiers who were electrocuted when their camp was flooded, the *New York Times* reported.

Egypt is home to fat-tailed scorpions that are among the most deadly in the world. Venom from a black fat-tail can kill humans in under an hour.

Extra doses of anti-venom were provided to medical centers in villages near mountains and deserts in Aswan after the scorpion swarm was reported.

orld Biz Magazine chose two Israeli chief executive officers—Hamutal Yitzhak of Else Nutrition and Shahar Fogel of Rookout—to receive "Top 100 Innovation CEO" awards for 2021.

As No. 1 on the list, Yitzhak was the subject of a multipage cover story for her role in "reshaping infant nutrition."

She spent years working with a team to develop Else Nutrition, the first plant-based, globally patented dairy-free and soy-free baby formula, which hit US store shelves last March.

World Biz Magazine Editor in Chief Mike Walters said: "We received over 40,000 entries for our 2021 awards. To be selected #1 is a testament to Hamutal's contributions to raising standards in infant and child nutrition."

**Commentary:** When Israel moved out of Egypt victoriously, they encountered scorpions in the desert: "Who led thee through that great and terrible wilderness, wherein were fiery serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where there was no water; who brought thee forth water out of the rock of flint" (Deuteronomy 8:15).

In the New Testament, Jesus admonishes us to ask, to seek, and to knock in prayer to the Heavenly Father. He then makes this statement: "If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion?" (Luke 11:11-12).

In Revelation 9, after the fifth angel sounds the trumpet, creatures from the bottomless pit shall ascend: "And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power" (Revelation 9:3). These are literally out-of-this-world creatures; they are called "locusts," but do something

locusts don't do: "And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that they should be tormented five months: and their torment was as the torment of a



scorpion, when he striketh a man" (verse 5).

# Tool to Help Read Documents 75% Faster

Amnon Shashua's AI21 Labs wants to help you read information faster. The company launched "Wordtune Read," an artificial intelligence-based reading companion designed to summarize documents and allow readers to get the information 75% faster.

Wordtune Read uses AI and machine learning to understand large amounts of written text and instantly summarize the key information, helping users get to the point of long documents straight away. Users simply upload a PDF or copy and paste a link of the text they want to read into the tool.

Within seconds, short snippets appear

alongside the text that identify and summarize the main themes of the document and help users rapidly decipher complex language. Its Spotlight feature can re-summarize the text from different points of view, putting the emphasis on the information the user is most interested in.

Al21 Labs is working to open up new technology uses for language and text. In August, the company released the world's largest and most sophisticated language model, "Jurassic-1 Jumbo," which can be used in text-based Al applications to read and understand text and learn to generate new text explaining it in multiple languages.

Al21 founder Shashua is also the entrepreneur behind autonomous driving company Mobileye, acquired in 2017 for \$15.3 billion, the largest-ever acquisition of an Israeli company; OrCam, which develops devices to assist the blind and visually impaired; and the First Digital Bank, which intends to open Israel's first new bank in 43 years online by the end of this year.

# ROBOTS TO REPLACE TROOPS


If you want to send robots where you don't want to send soldiers, you need a solution for that," said Elad Levy, CEO and founder of Roboteam.

His company, together with Elbit Systems, announced the debut of what they are calling "the mothership of unmanned vehicles": ROOK, a multipayload military 6x6 Unmanned Ground Vehicle (UGV).

He said the ROOK is the next step toward enabling "everything that happens in the sky" through use of drones and aerial robots to occur on the ground and in the field where soldiers need it, too.

The company expects the machine to be used to deliver supplies, function as medevac to pull casualties from the field, take part in intelligence gathering missions—including carrying and dispatching drones—and serve as a remote weapons system.

To accumulate knowledge is definitely recommended, but there is something better: wisdom. "How much better is it to get wisdom than gold! and to get understanding rather to be chosen than silver!" (Proverbs 16:16).

As to real knowledge: "Now as touching things offered unto idols, we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffeth up, but charity edifieth. And if any man think that he knoweth any thing, he knoweth nothing yet as he ought to know. But if any man love God, the same is known of him" (1 Corinthians 8:1-3).

The apostle Paul gives instruction to his spiritual son Timothy: "O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called" (1 Timothy 6:20).

# Communist Party Rejects Boycott of Jews

While communism is associated with the statement by former President Reagan, "The Evil Empire," it is of interest that the communist Soviet Union was first to recognize





the State of Israel. That was on 17 May 1948, followed by Nicaragua, Czechoslovakia, Yugoslavia, and Poland. The United States extended recognition to the State of Israel after the first Israeli election on 24 January 1949.

This is not a surprise, because the overwhelming majority of the signatories of the Declaration of Independence of Israel were communist-educated and originated from the former Soviet Union.

Here again we see the mixture between the various political ideologies. Austria can be considered a social-capitalist country, while China practices a communist-social-capitalist ideology - and that rather successfully.

# **UNRWA FACES COLLAPSE**

The UN Relief and Works Agency that services Palestinian refugees is close to collapse due to vicious political attacks and lack of funding, its commissioner, General Philippe Lazzarini, told a donor conference in Brussels.

Lazzarini told reporters that UNRWA's budget has been largely stagnant since 2013. even though the refugee population, as well as its needs, has grown.

UNRWA services 5.7 million Palestinian refugees in Syria, Lebanon, Jordan, Gaza, the West Bank and east Jerusalem.

"UNRWA has long been part of the problem and not part of the solution," Israel's ambassador to the UN Gilad Frdan said in a statement from Jerusalem, "Instead of functioning as an agency for humanitarian and educational assistance, the agency functions as a political body that promotes the Hamas narrative [and] allows incitement against, and delegitimization of, Israel to be written into Palestinian [school] textbooks."

# Weizmann Ranks 8th for Scientific Performance

Israel's Weizmann Institute of Science has maintained its reputation as one of the top research institutions worldwide, with a recent ranking placing it at No. 8 globally for scientific performance.

The ranking is not subjective and is based on the number of publications and citations to indicate the quality of research, as well as the institution's size.

Overall, 19% of Weizmann papers were ranked in the top 10% for scientific impact, as were over 20% of papers written by Weizmann's biomedical and health science researchers. A total of 2.5% of Weizmann papers were in the top percentile for scientific impact, and 65% were in the top half of those with the greatest impact of all.

Weizmann was also recognized by U-Multi-rank 2021, a European Commission initiative. This saw Weizmann ranked in the top 25 institutes worldwide for patents awarded and top-cited publications.

# The Ancient Way to Keep Cool

Among Yazd's ancient technologies is the wind catcher, or *bâdgir* in Persian. These remarkable structures are a common sight soaring above the rooftops of Yazd. They are often rectangular towers, but they also appear in circular, square, octagonal and other ornate shapes.



The openings of the towers face the prevailing wind, catching it and funneling it down to the interior below (Credit: Alamy)

Yazd is said to have the most wind catchers in the world, though they may have originated in ancient Egypt. In Yazd, the wind catcher soon proved indispensable, making this part of the hot and arid Iranian Plateau livable.

As a wind catcher requires no electricity to power it, it is both a cost-efficient and green form of cooling. With conventional mechanical air conditioning already accounting for a fifth of total electricity consumption globally, ancient alternatives like the wind catcher are becoming an increasingly appealing option.

The shape of the tower, alongside factors like the layout of the house, the direction the tower is facing, how many openings it has, its configuration of fixed internal blades, canals and height are all finely tuned to improve the tower's

# 3D-PRINTED, **PLANT-BASED** MEAT

sraeli startup Redefine Meat will begin offering 3D-printed plant-based "meat" products at select high-end restaurants in Europe, the company announced.

In doing so, the company claimed to have "cracked the holy grail of the alternative meat industry," which is largely producing minced products that often lack the fibrous texture found in animal meat.

Redefine Meat's range of products, called New Meat. now includes the whole cuts. plus burgers, sausages, lamb kebabs, and ground beef as it hopes to become "the world's largest meat company by offering every single cut that a cow does."

In Israel, dishes with Redefine Meat's products are sold in some 150 restaurants and establishments. according to the company. including Coffee Bar and Hotel Montefiore in Tel Aviv.

The company is working on a launch in the US and Asia.

ability to draw wind down into the dwellings below.

Wherever it was first invented, wind catchers have since become widespread across the Middle East and North Africa. Variations of Iran's wind catchers can be found in the *barjeels* of Qatar and Bahrain, the *malqaf* of Egypt, the *mungh* of Pakistan, and many other places, notes Fatemeh Jomehzadeh of the University of Technology Malaysia and colleagues.

Parham Kheirkhah Sangdeh has extensively studied the scientific application and surrounding culture of wind catchers in contemporary architecture at Ilam University in Iran. He says inconveniences like pests entering the chutes and the gathering of dust and desert debris have meant many have turned away from traditional wind catchers.

While researchers such as Kheirkhah Sangdeh argue that the wind catcher has much more to give in cooling homes without fossil fuels, this ingenious technology has already migrated further around the world than you might think.

# Joint Industrial Zone in Gaza?

Is Arazim—the name of the industrial area shared by Israel and Gaza—really about to happen? *Maariv* learned that a significant planning phase has been completed that examined the feasibility of establishing an industrial zone—in Israeli territory, near the ruins of the Erez industrial zone, which Israel demolished in 2004 prior to the disengagement from the Gaza Strip.

According to various estimates, it will be possible to employ thousands of workers in the planned industrial area. Meanwhile, with regard to the movement of merchants from the Gaza Strip, the data available to the defense establishment show that after setting the quota at 10,000 merchants who can enter daily, the entry of more than 7,000 citizens in Gaza who have a permit and leave for Israel has already been approved.

Although officially these are supposed to be merchants, the vast majority are employed as workers, including workers in agriculture who, after 15 years of disengagement, returned to work in the fields of kibbutzim in Gaza border communities. The defense establishment is now seeking to regulate permits for workers as well.

**Commentary:** Gaza is ruled by Hamas, declared to be a terrorist organization by 31 nations. Australia, New Zealand, Paraguay, and the United Kingdom only designate the military wing of Hamas as a terrorist entity.

I t was the Gentile widow Ruth who received the wonderful promise, "The Lord make the woman that is come into thine house like Rachel and like Leah, which two did build the house of Israel." These words were uttered by the people and the elders.

Later, when Boaz married Ruth and a son was born, the women of Bethlehem made this prophecy: "that his name may be famous in Israel" (verse 14b). The women enlarged the promise from "famous in Bethlehem" to "famous in Israel."

Almost 600 years later, we read another prophecy: "But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting" (Micah 5:2). While Bethlehem is somewhat insignificant when compared to other cities in Judea, the promise is irrevocable: the Ruler of Israel shall come forth, and His "goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting"—meaning eternity.

Insignificant, little Bethlehem became the territory where God revealed Himself in the flesh.

Speaking of Rachel, she died when she gave birth to Benjamin. We read in Genesis 35:18: "And it came to pass, as her soul was in departing, (for she died) that she called his name Benoni: but his father called him Benjamin." For Rachel, it was Benoni, "the son of

my sorrow," but Jacob changed the name to Benjamin, which means, "the son of my right hand." Benjamin was the first tribe integrated into the tribe of Judah, hence became Jews.

Before Iacob died and before he blessed his son and grandsons, he speaks of the death of Rachel: "And as for me, when I came from Padan, Rachel died by me in the land of Canaan in the way, when yet there was but a little way to come unto Ephrath: and I buried her there in the way of Ephrath; the same is Bethlehem" (Genesis 48:7). That burial place, called Rachel's Tomb, is located at the northern entrance of Bethlehem. It is part of Palestinian territory and difficult for visitors to access. That is another tragedy for Israel.

In the New Testament, we read the genealogy from Abraham to Joseph, the husband of Mary. Ruth is mentioned: "And Salmon begat Booz of Rachab; and Booz begat Obed of Ruth; and Obed begat Jesse" (Matthew 1:5).

# **Bethlehem Today**

The Arab name for this city is *Bayt Lahm*, which means "house of meat." In Hebrew it means "house of bread." Today, this little town is located in the Judean hills some 8 kilometers south of Jerusalem. It is no longer considered part of Israel.

To visit Bethlehem as a tourist, one needs to go to an exchange point located outside the city. There you must disembark the Israeli vehicle and board a Palestinian bus or taxi, which takes you into Bethlehem.

# Cities of Refuge

We know from Joshua 14:3-4, 21:1-45, and Numbers 35:6-15, that six cities were ordained to be cities of refuge. Three—Hebron, Shechem, and Kedesh—are in



what is now called Palestinian territory. To the east of the Jordan, there are the cities of Bezer, Ramoth in Gilead, and Golan in Bashan; subsequently called Jordanian territory.

When one views today's political reality, there shockingly seems to be no refuge for Israel as outlined in Holy Scripture.

Bethlehem today has a population under 30,000, of which about 17% are adherents to the Christian religion, although not necessarily believers

In summary, today virtually no Jews live in Bethlehem or in the six cities of refuge. For Bible believers, that sounds rather hopeless. But it is not, for the prophetic Word proclaims: "I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely: for mine anger is turned away from him. I will be as the dew unto Israel: he shall grow as the lily, and cast forth his roots as Lebanon. His branches shall spread, and his beauty shall be as the olive tree, and his smell as Lebanon. They that dwell under his shadow shall return; they shall revive as the corn, and grow as the vine: the scent thereof shall be as the wine of Lebanon" (Hosea 14:4-7). (NF)

pecially Lebanon. At present, it is on very shaky ground. Over the last decades, Lebanon has grown more and more unstable, and right now there is great tension. Our enemy Hezbollah is attempting to usurp rulership in Lebanon, and we do not know where this will lead.

While writing this article, all is quiet, but we realize this could change in the blink of an eye and at any moment. We appreciate and ask for your prayers, especially during times like these.

# EBENEZER HOME



Israeli officials, including the Ministry of Defense, Ministry of Welfare, and the Home Front Command, have urged us to upgrade our protection for the Home, to prepare for any upcoming events. We need to ensure (to the extent we can) that the residents and those who are visiting Ebenezer Home, will be safe and will have fewer chances of being injured in the event of a missile attack with explosions nearby.

It required us to cover all our glass windows with a transparent, 200 micro-millimeter polymer sheathing that sticks onto the glass. This would prevent glass shards from flying onto the nearby residents and/or staff if an explosion happens.

It's an enormous burden on us, as we have many, many windows, but we understand the absolute necessity of complying with these newest requirements! We will continue to do whatever is within our power to seek the safety and protection of our residents and team.

We don't know of another material that could provide protection from flying glass shards as this specially designed polymer does. Yes, we realize that ultimately, our protection and help comes from our Savior Yeshua: as the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob says in the introductory verses, HE will cover us! But we must also be prudent and do whatever is within our power to care for those whom HE has entrusted to Ebenezer.

For this reason, we are dedicating this month to raising the needed finances to cover the cost of this project. We have put together a video for you about it, which you can view on our YouTube channel: Ebenezer Senior Citizens Home.

We are in need of 3665 square feet of this polymer sheathing for our glass windows. For every 50 sq. ft covered, it costs \$145. Will you join us in helping with the expense of this task?
