"He Died on the Ascent."

ur title is the text of a memorial plaque on a mountain in the Alps, erected in memory of a mountain guide who died while rescuing an injured person.

The Bible says of Aaron, "And Aaron the priest went up into mount Hor at the commandment of the LORD, and died there..." (Num 33:38a). We also read that Moses was commanded to go up Mount Abarim, to look out at the land that the Lord had given to Israel. After seeing it, he too would die (Num 27:12-13).

The year is still young. There's much to do, for which we'll need to look up to where Christ is, at God's right hand (Col 3:1). The very next verse reads, "Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth."

There are vines that climb higher and higher to better develop. The bean, for example, belongs to this group of plants. The older it gets, the faster it spreads. The tendrils only coil once a day at first. But later on, they can coil as much as eight times in 24 hours, and always upwards.

One principle always applies: everyone has to climb up if they want to thrive. Climbing plants that don't find support—instead having to crawl along the ground—are usually stunted, unsightly, and don't bear fruit.

This is an apt example for our life. We must be oriented upward in order to bear fruit. Being earthly-minded inhibits our spiritual growth. We wither and don't bear fruit. The Lord Jesus gives us support, so let's orient ourselves to Him, clinging to Him and His Word in faith. That's what will allow us to grow, prosper, and bear fruit. He alone is our support.

Don't we sometimes (or all too often) focus our minds more on the earth than where Christ is? We let ourselves be captivated by worldly things, by worries, by pursuing wealth, by hoarding things, or even by lusts and desires. Many people are engrossed in conspiracy theories right now. The world seems to be spinning out of control, and they're hypnotized like a deer in the headlights. They believe everything that is presented to them without

fact-checking it, which is most alarming. Quite a few—Christians among them—are withering away. Some are only looking at the dark side and are falling by the wayside spiritually. Why? Because they are so tied to earthly things. Our earthly senses are captured by worries about the coronavirus, or fear of an economic crash or inflation. A friend wrote to me, "This daily red alert is making us afraid, and fear is the best breeding ground for irrational behavior."

This certainly isn't what God wants. He wants us to raise our eyes to His Son, as the Author and Perfecter of our faith. He wants us to seek His kingdom, and to be heavenly beacons of hope for those trapped by the world. "He died on the ascent." We want to keep ascending until we're with Him. MO

Opinions differ among theologians as to what, exactly, the Thousand-Year Kingdom is. A definition from the perspective of biblical prophecy.

he Thousand-Year Kingdom—the Millennium—is the promised Messianic Kingdom. With the appearance of the Messiah as King, the Kingdom will dawn. This refers to the epoch of history when Christ will return personally to bring world peace, God's rule, complete righteousness, and blessings to the earth. From Revelation 20, we learn that this time will last 1,000 years. And from First Corinthians 15, we learn that Jesus Christ, the King, will hand this Kingdom over to the Father and usher it into eternity.

The Kingdom is the subject of many prophecies in both the Old and New Testaments. We read in the book of the prophet Isaiah:

"It shall come to pass in the last days...he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more....The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid...the cow and the bear shall feed...the sucking child shall play on the hole of the asp...They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea...The whole earth is at rest, and is quiet: they break forth into singing" (Is 2:2-4; 11:6-9; 14:7).

These verses show that this Kingdom will satisfy the deepest longings of all individuals and nations here on earth. It brings renewal of creation, changes in nature and, above all, a worldwide knowledge of God.

All of this will be possible because Satan will have been bound in advance and locked in the abyss. Temptation will no longer be a reality during this time. Jesus' kingship will be God's self-justification.

Although this Kingdom was discredited by sects or theologians as a "carnal Jewish expectation" due to certain exaggerations, and perverted by the world as some kind of Shangri-la, the biblical testimony is clear: the Kingdom of Jesus Christ brings a sweeping knowledge of religious truth to people that had never existed before. It will be a Kingdom full of spiritual goods, and will bring the visible reign of Jesus Christ on earth. Additionally, Scripture leaves no doubt that we as believers will have a share in it: "...they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years" (Rev 20:4). The reign of the believers in the Millennial Kingdom will fulfill mankind's mandate that had been given in Paradise.

The Millennium Is Forthcoming

Although there are commendable Bible teachers who believe that the Millennium shouldn't be taken literally, and that it will be identical to the time of the Church of Jesus (amillennialism), we believe (like nearly all the church fathers of the first two centuries) that Jesus will come again to establish His literal, visible Kingdom. In anticipation of the second coming of Jesus prior to the Millennium, we therefore call ourselves *premillennialists*.

There are many reasons for believing that the Millennium is yet to come:

First, Jesus prayed for the coming of this blessed time in the Lord's Prayer: "Thy king-

dom come." In this way, he was signaling that the Kingdom—beyond the form of God's Kingdom as it exists today—is the goal of all redemptive history, which still awaits fulfillment.

Second, Jesus was remembering the Kingdom when He spoke of judgment upon the nations. At the time of this judgment—which occurs at His Second Coming—He will say to His own, "Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world" (Matt 25:34). If He will say this at His Second Coming, this Kingdom is still in the future and could never, ever be synonymous with the Church Age.

Third, the Apostles also demonstrated their expectation of a future Kingdom when they asked the Lord whether this Kingdom would

coincide with the time of the Church: "Lord. wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?" (Acts 1:6). They received a negative answer. So, they also believed that Israel still had a future as a nation in God's plan of salvation! That's why they preached to their own Jewish people that there was a requirement to fulfill both the Kingdom and

the future of Israel: "Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord. And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began" (Acts 3:19-21).

Fourth, the Millennial Kingdom is in the future because it follows naturally from the course of redemptive history. Ephesians 1 describes the blessings for believers that the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit will give to His own at different times:

1. Before the world began, the Father determined the sonship of His own (vv. 4-6).

So, we can truly say that the Gospel is a "Gospel of the Kingdom," because it leads to God's reign. After thousands of years, God's glory will be made great in the Millennium, and the Lord will be justified in all His actions.

- 2. During the time that Jesus lived on earth, the Son worked redemption (vv. 7-9).
- 3. In the future consummation, believers will be granted the blessings of the Holy Spirit in perfection. "Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession..." (v. 14).

This includes both the future inheritance (vv. 11, 14) and that in the "fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth..." (v. 10). This expresses that one day, in the fulfillment of the times (plural!), everyone on earth will stand under one head; namely, the reign of Jesus Christ. To "gather together in one all things" actually means to bring it under headship; that is, to put it under one head. This will be the "fullness of times, [when] he might gather together in one all things in Christ." And this has to be a reference to the Millennium because:

- a) It obviously occurs in the future, and is therefore unfulfilled in the present Church Age.
- b) It is a (salvation) economy or administration—that is, a redemptive time that brings all the others together or brings them to their goal; precisely, the "fulfillment of the [many] times." Such (salvation) times (Greek *kairos*) are times in which God reveals Himself differently (e.g. under law, under grace). The word *kairos* characterizes a time according to its content and essence, as a kind of time of rev-

elation. Man must recognize this current time as a time of grace and opportunity for himself (cf. Tit 1:3).

- c) The administration of the fullness of times brings us His Second Coming and the reign of the King. The "fullness of the time" (Gal 4:4; Gr. *chronos*, chronological time) was reached to some degree in the middle of history, when Jesus Christ was born as a human being at His first coming in order to accomplish redemption. And the Millennial Kingdom will advance the goal: "The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ" (Rev 11:15).
- d) We can also see from the Lord's Prayer that the Millennium will be when the times will be fulfilled: "Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven" (Matt 6:10). Only in this future Kingdom will all people come under one head, and only in the Millennium will God's will be obeyed in both places; namely, on "earth, as it is in heaven." Only in the Millennial Kingdom will things in heaven and things on earth be united in Him, under His head (Eph 1:10).

So, we can truly say that the Gospel is a "Gospel of the Kingdom," because it leads to God's reign. After thousands of years, God's glory will be made great in the Millennium, and the Lord will be justified in all His actions. In addition, the promises of the Old Testament covenants (namely, the return and spiritual restoration of Israel) will be entirely fulfilled.

If a believer is to live a victorious (successful) Christian life—one that empowers him or her to avoid excesses of the flesh, to enjoy more of God's peace, and to be strengthened to live an abundant life that glorifies the Lord—it is absolutely essential to depend upon the ministry of the Holy Spirit.

wight L. Moody once illustrated this truth as follows: "Tell me," he said to his audience, "how can I get the air out of this glass?" One man said, "Suck it out with a pump." Moody replied, "That would create a vacuum and shatter the glass." After many impossible suggestions, Moody smiled, picked up a pitcher of water, and filled the glass. "There," he said, "all the air is now removed." He then went on to show that victory in the Christian life is not by "sucking out a sin here

and there," but rather being filled with the Spirit (Al Bryant, comp. ed., Worship Services [Grand Rapids: Kregel, 1992] 59).

To live a life pleasing to the Lord God is vastly superior to any other. The joy of living a life devoted to God—by grace through faith in Christ—is recognizing that the Lord's divine commands are always satisfied with His divine provisions. Sometimes, "the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life" may be overwhelming, but the Holy Spirit—who abides

within every believer—is greater than those sinful enticements (cf. 1 John 2:16; 4:4). Scripture teaches that if you walk in the Spirit, you will not fulfill the lusts of the flesh. Victory is by God's grace through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

The Deity of the Spirit

If one is to remain faithful to the Word of God, one must confess that the Bible is unequivocal in its assertion that there is one God. Also, that there are three distinct personalities in the Old and New Testaments, who all possess the attributes, character, and nature of deity. The English word "trinity" is derived from the Latin *trinitas*, which means "three." The word does not appear in the Bible; rather, it is a theological term for the one true God, who is self-revealed within the Bible as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Scripture reveals there is only one God (Deut 6:4; Isa 43:10; 1 Cor 8:6). The true God is triune: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are three distinct, eternal, equal Persons, yet one Being. The Father is God (Rom 1:7; Eph 4:6), the Son is God (John 1:1; 20:28; Tit 2:13), and the Holy Spirit is God (Acts 5:3-4; John 14:26; Heb 9:14). Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are united in the Godhead; thus, they have the same substance but are distinct in subsistence (Matt 3:16-17; John 14:16).

The present article will examine how the Holy Spirit empowers the believer in his/her battle with the "flesh." Some New Testament expressions and texts will be noted, which reveal specific information regarding how the third member of the triune God, the Holy

Spirit, accomplishes His work in the life of the believer.

The Leading of the Spirit

(Gal 5:16-17) The biblical expression "against the flesh" describes an aspect of the Holy Spirit's work within the believer. The "desire" of the flesh is contrary to the Spirit's work. The word translated "desire" is the Greek word *epithumian*, and indicates a "craving" that can be either good or evil. The "desire" of the flesh (v. 17) is to oppose the command to "not carry out the desire" (v. 16), and thus indicates what is sinful. When "desire" is used in reference to the Holy Spirit, it indicates what is good, because the intent is for the will of God to be accomplished.

The truth that the Holy Spirit is "against the flesh" indicates a tension (struggle) that exists within the life of the believer. Being "led by the Spirit" involves God's work in creating a resistance to the desires of the flesh (viz. tendencies that remain from one's prior unregenerate state). One aspect of the Spirit's leading "against the flesh" is convicting the believer that a particular desire of the flesh is indeed sin (John 16:8). When the flesh resists the Spirit's leading, this results in somewhat of an impasse. Effectually, the flesh's desire prevents the believer, "so that you may not do the things that you please" (as a new creation in Christ). If the Holy Spirit did not provide conviction "against the flesh," the believer would experience the precise condition described in Romans 7:14-24. This entails desperately wanting "the good," yet not being able "to do good."

The Empowering of the Spirit

(Rom 8:1-14; Eph 5:18-21) The impasse between the flesh and the Spirit can be overcome by walking according to the Spirit. "Walk" is a metaphor for one's lifestyle. To "walk" in the Spirit means depending upon the Holy Spirit, so He will empower your actions and determination. Consequently, it will be possible to defy "the things of the flesh" and fulfill "the requirement of the Law" (viz. doing God's will). To walk in the Spirit is to live (purposely) relying upon God to empower you in persevering "to do good."

The Holy Bible commands believers to "be filled with the Spirit," which means to be controlled or influenced by God. Ephesians 5:18-21 implies that being filled with the Spirit is a quality of life, as opposed to a solitary, mystical experience. When the day of Pentecost arrived, the disciples "were all filled with the Holy Spirit" in connection with the baptism of the Spirit. Spirit baptism is not commanded in Scripture (since it is a sovereign work of God in response to our faith and repentance, leading to conversion: the "new birth"), and thus it is a solitary event in the life of a believer. However, "filling" by the Spirit is commanded and is to be characteristic of the believer's life.

Spirit baptism is the work of Jesus Christ whereby the church receives and is indwelt by the Holy Spirit, which incorporates it into one body of Christ and identifies it with the Lord's death and resurrection (John 14:16-17; Rom 6:1-11; 1 Cor 6:19; 12:13). At the ascension of

Christ (ca. spring, AD 30-33), the baptism of the Holy Spirit was still future (Acts 1:5). Pentecost (2:1-36) was the fulfillment of Jesus' promise (cf. 11:15-16).

Another phrase related to the empowering of the Spirit involves "the mind set on the Spirit" (Rom 8:5-6). The expression indicates that we are significantly affected by our mental attitude. The believer's determination is to allow the Holy Spirit to accomplish the will of God in our lives. "Being led by the Spirit of God" involves "putting to death the deeds of the body" (vv. 13-14), which means rejecting sinful impulses and submitting instead to the Holy Spirit's guidance.

The Illumination of the Spirit

(1 Cor 2:6-16; 1 John 2:20-21) The Holy Spirit guides the believer with the Word of God by illuminating (making understandable) the Bible. First Corinthians 2:6-16 indicates that the Holy Spirit reveals "the thoughts of God" and enables the believer ("he who is spiritual") to appraise "all things." First John 2:20-21 explains that believers will "know the truth" when it is proclaimed, because they "have an anointing from the Holy One." The believer is able to know the truth or will of God as it is revealed in the Holy Bible. The Holy Spirit guides the believer in every decision that needs to be made, by His work of revealing "God's wisdom" in the Bible. He then makes that spiritual truth and wisdom understandable.

"The fruit of the Spirit" is essentially the Christlikeness that is to be manifested in the life of a believer. The nine elements of the fruit of the Spirit should be understood as a whole (Gal 5:22-23).

Those whom the Spirit enlightens welcome God's wisdom (1 Cor 2:10-11). The means by which God provides the knowledge of His thoughts is the Holy Spirit, who is the only One who completely understands the mind of God. The thoughts of God would be impossible to know without the working of the Holy Spirit. It was His task to supervise the writing of the Scriptures. The Bible is a record of the thoughts of God, and those who study it are able to know all the things that God has "freely given" (2:12).

The spiritual (mature) person is controlled by the Holy Spirit (cf. Rom 8:6-8), and thus enjoys the special privilege of being able to appraise all things. This means they can examine all things carefully and distinguish what is important. Someone who has "the mind of Christ" is able to make the right decisions concerning life. The wisdom needed today for life decisions is available through God's revelation (the Bible).

The Fruit of the Spirit

(Gal 5:22-23) The familiar passage of Scripture that lists "the fruit of the Spirit" immediately follows the section explaining how to "walk by the Spirit" (vv. 16-21). The believer walks by the Spirit when he/she obeys God, as opposed to heeding the desires of the flesh. The results of being led by the Spirit include: "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control."



Dependence upon the Holy Spirit is the means by which the "fruit" is cultivated, and how it attains maturity in the believer's life. When people walk by the Spirit, they assent to the Holy Spirit's power to change the behaviors of their sinful character and transform them into the image of Jesus, so that they are even able to "have the mind of Christ" (cf. 1 Cor 2:16).

"The fruit of the Spirit" is essentially the Christlikeness that is to be manifested in the life of a believer. The nine elements of the fruit of the Spirit should be understood as a whole (Gal 5:22-23). A person is not entirely under the control of the Holy Spirit unless there is evidence of all elements of the fruit. A person's life is defective when one or more aspects of the fruit are absent, because Christ died to provide freedom from "the flesh with its passions and desires" (v. 24). The flesh is "crucified" when a person trusts in what Christ did for him/her on the cross, and becomes identified with Him. The Holy Spirit is the believer's strength for living a life of victory to the glory of God (vv. 25-26). (1195)

Those Who Sit on the Throne of Wealth

A German cardinal has claimed that the coronavirus pandemic has been used by the likes of George Soros and Bill Gates to create a global "surveillance state."

Gerhard Ludwig Mueller, a high-ranking Vatican court judge, has said in an interview with Austria's St. Boniface Institute that the Covid-19 pandemic has caused "chaos" and "confusion" stemming not only from a "lack of knowledge" about the transmissibility and danger of the virus itself but from the willingness of the super-rich to "seize the opportunity to lure people in."

"People, who sit on the throne of their wealth" see an "opportunity to push their agenda," the cardinal said, naming Microsoft co-founder Bill Gates, billionaire George Soros and Davos Economic Forum head Klaus Schwab among those behind the global control scheme.

The cardinal then accused the global financial elites of an attempt to give birth to "a new man" created "in their image and likeness," adding that he would not wish such a fate for himself.

Religion Declines During Pandemic

Religious affiliation in the U.S. has continued to fall during the pandemic, according to a new survey from the Pew Research Center.



Survey shows the percentage of Americans with no religious affiliation rose to 29%, while Christians declined to 63%

Many places of worship closed during the pandemic—some voluntarily, others as a result of state and local social-distancing rules—and inperson church attendance is roughly 30% to 50% lower than it was before the pandemic, estimates Barna Group, a research firm that studies faith in the U.S. Millions of Americans moved to worshiping online, and questions linger about how many will come back in person.

The share of Americans who pray daily fell to 45% in 2021, compared with 58% in 2007.

"The secularizing trends that have been evident for a long time show no signs of

slowing, certainly no signs of reversing," said Greg Smith, author of the study.

Though Protestants remain the largest group, most of the drop in religious affiliation has come from their ranks. Some 40% of Americans now identify as Protestant, compared with 43% in 2019 and 52% in 2007.

Other religious groups have remained relatively stable over the past two years. Catholics make up 21% of the adult population, up 1 percentage point from 2019. Non-Christian faiths, including Islam and Judaism, collectively make up about 6% of the adult population, down from 7% two years ago.

Commentary: While this survey is quite interesting, we must keep in mind that none is ever 100% accurate. What is significant is that those who pray daily decreased from 58% in 2007 to 45% in 2021. But again, these are statistics, which really do not represent the Church of Jesus Christ, His body.

We are observing the slow integration of the religions of the world, which is in part fueled by merchandise. Never before in history has international trade been so significant as in these days.

Where will it lead? The whole world will unitedly follow the Old Serpent's superman, Antichrist, who will create peace, prosperity, and security for all people in the world—although only temporarily.

Donating 10 Percent to Charity

John Yan has decided to start giving away at least 15% of his annual salary, despite it meaning that he'll have to work longer into his old age.

The 27-year-old software engineer began donating part of his wages in 2019, pledging 1% that year, before raising it to 3% in 2020, and then a big jump to 15% in 2021.

"In practical terms this commitment means I'm not going to retire early,"

says Mr. Yan, who lives and works in New York City. "And maybe looking ahead, I won't be able to send my kids to private [fee-paying] school."

He is donating the money via a global scheme called Giving What We Can (GWWC). This encourages people to sign up as a member and pledge to give 10% of their earnings to charity.

Mr. Yan, who is the child of first-generation immigrants to the US, says he knows that he is "doing better than a lot of people in the world" and wanted to give something back—to help others.

But why encourage people to give away 10% of their income rather a than higher or lower level?

"The amount was chosen because it strikes a good balance of being both significant and sustainable," says GWWC executive director Luke Freeman. "It is a significant proportion of one's income, but it is also within reach of most people in rich countries."

He also points to the historical connection of the idea of tithing, a tradition in both Judaism and Christianity of giving 10% of vour income to charity or the church.

Synagogue from Mary Magdalene's Town Discovered

A 2,000-year-old synagogue was discovered in the ancient Jewish settlement of Migdal in Galilee, the second synagogue from the Second Temple Period uncovered in the town, also known as Magdala. The location is prominently featured both in the Jewish-Roman historian Flavius Josephus' writings, and as the birthplace of Mary Magdalene in the Gospels.

In the first century CE, Migdal was also the main base of Yosef ben Matityahu (Flavius Josephus), who served as commander of the rebellion against the Romans in Galilee before he surrendered to them and eventually obtained Roman citizenship.

The first synagogue was uncovered in the Migdal in 2009, when an excavation by the Israel Antiquities Authority unearthed Jewish ritual baths (mikvaot), streets, a marketplace and industrial facilities. A unique artifact stood in the middle of the synagogue's main hall: a large stone portraying the Second Temple of Jerusalem, with a carved seven-branched menorah on one of its

sides. It represented a crucial discovery because the depiction was engraved in the stone when the temple was still standing.


"The synagogue we are excavating now is close to the residential street. whereas the one excavated in 2009 was surrounded by an industrial area." said Prof. Adi Erlich. "Thus the local synagogues were constructed within the social fabric of the settlement."

The excavation was initiated as a salvage excavation prior to construction works at the Migdal intersection. According to Israeli law, all development projects need to be accompanied by such an excavation.

40,000 Afghan Refugees Accepted

A group of 15 European Union member states has agreed to take in 40,000 Afghans for resettlement, Commissioner Ylva Johansson said after meeting interior ministers of those countries.

Germany will accept the bulk of the new arrivals, with 25,000. with the Netherlands accepting 3,159, Spain and France 2,500 each, and other countries in lower numbers, according to a document seen by the AFP news agency.

There are an estimated 85.000 Afghans who have fled their homeland into countries nearer the EU, and the Taliban's capture of power on August 15, coupled with a fierce drought, could trigger new flows.

UNHCR chief Filippo Grandi has warned that 85,000 Afghans who are living in vulnerable situations outside the bloc need resettlement, and has urged Europe to take half.

acceptance of refugees from Syria and Iraq has caused the rise of extreme right-wing political philosophy in many European countries. This is enshrined in the laws of nearly all nations around the world that are signatories to the Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees, first ratified in 1951.

What does the Bible say? Way back in the beginning, Israel is ordered, "Thou shalt neither vex a stranger, nor oppress him: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt" (Exodus 22:21). Leviticus 19:34 adds: "But the stranger that dwelleth with you shall be unto you as one born among you, and thou shalt love him as thyself; for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the Lord your God." We, the Church of Jesus Christ on earth, are impartial. Third John 1:5 reads: "Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers." Recent history clearly reveals that those who have lost their home, their family, their language, culture, traditions, and history, are often very receptive to the love shown to them by Christians.

During a recent conversation with someone in Germany, a question regarding new con-

verts was answered, "Virtually all the new converts in recent years are foreigners." That is fulfillment of the words of Jesus, "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven" (Matthew 5:16). We must take notice of the succession: our light—that is, our fellowship with Jesus—should reveal the works." Often, we make the mistake

"It hath pleased them verily; and their debtors they are. For if the Gentiles have been made partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister unto them in carnal things" (Romans 15:27).

ur relationship to Israel is exemplified in the above Scripture. We have been "made partakers of their spiritual things." True: the Bible is a Jewish book from Genesis to Revelation. Jesus Himself stated, "Salvation is of the Jews." There should be no question, no debate, no theological discussion. The Church, the one consisting exclusively of born-again people, owes its position to Israel. God was revealed in the flesh in Israel. He walked the land from the east to the west, from the north to the south.

While on earth, He told a Gentile woman who petitioned Him about her daughter, "It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it to dogs" (Matthew 15:26). At first glance, that seems heartless, cold, and extremely prejudiced to foreigners. Reading the story, we notice that this woman of Canaan did not act in accordance with her position. She addressed Him, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou son of David." That form of address was reserved for the Jews, not the Gentiles. Apparently, she realized her mistake; in verse 25b she cries out, "Lord, help me."

It is not our task or calling to analyze Israel's behavior and their political maneuvering—our relationship is spiritual. In proper alignment with Scripture, we also minister to them in carnal things. We are organically connected.

Israel has received multiple promises about their future, one being the borders of the Promised Land. No other country can be called the Promised Land—only the land of Israel. Yet we as Christians should never get actively involved in the political process of the nation of Israel.

A recent article in the *Jerusalem Post* stated, "129 nations ignore Jewish ties to Temple Mount." The resolution was approved 129 to 11 by the United Nations General Assembly, stating that the Temple Mount should be called solely by its Muslim name al-Haram al-Sharif. But an EU representative said, "The EU reiterates that whenever referring to the Temple Mount/al-Haram al-Sharif in the Jerusalem resolution, both terms, i.e., Temple Mount and al-Haram al-Sharif should be used."

In view of these developments, something else is of great interest, revealed by another headline, "Israel signs Horizon Europe deal despite West Bank exclusion." Here an excerpt:

Israel signed a major research and innovation agreement with the European Union known as Horizon Europe, despite the exclusion of West Bank settlements, east Jerusalem and the Golan Heights from the program.

Horizon Europe, which will be in place through 2027, is the largest global research program in the world with a budget of €95.5 billion (\$106.8b.).

"Today's agreement will allow Israelis and European scientists, innovators and researchers to continue to work together on the solutions of tomorrow through cutting edge technologies," Science, Technology, and Space Minister Orit Farkash-Hacohen (Blue and White) said during a short virtual ceremony held between Jerusalem and Brussels. "This agreement gives a voice of recognition to Israeli innovation and reaches what is our most precious natural resource."

According to the European Commission, "Israel ranked third in terms of overall participation in the program [Horizon 2020] and was among the best performers." For the purpose of these programs, Israel is granted the same status as the 27 EU member states.

This is the world's largest global research program, with a budget of 95.5 billion euros. Considering that most European nations are either neutral or somewhat anti-Israel, why was Israel invited to join this exclusive scientific club? A number of other countries have applied for asso-

ciate membership, but only Israel has been accepted into Horizon Europe.

Another gigantic European project involves over 10,000 scientists from around 100 countries. Under the leadership of 21 countries, all are European but one: Israel. The Large Hadron Collider is the world's largest and most powerful energy particle collider. Its location is the Swiss-France border just outside Geneva. It is home to the world's largest physics laboratory.

When we consider these facts, we first of all realize that Israel is special. But we also understand that the Europeans need Israel. Otherwise, Israel would not have attained membership in this prestigious European project. Is Israel's knowledge essential for these gigantic projects? Apparently.

But there is a different knowledge that Israel will seek after. Amos writes: "Behold, the days come, saith the Lord God, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord" (8:11). Israel has not yet seriously searched for the Truth. They will find Him, who said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life."

How Revelation 19, the *Hallel* Psalms, and the Lord's Last Supper point to Christ's future millennial kingdom in Israel.

Begin His reign here on earth, a hallelujah rings out in heaven: "And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth" (Rev 19:6).

How did Jesus teach His disciples to pray? The English Standard Version

translates it this way: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven" (Matt 6:9-10).

When Jesus Christ appears in glory, it is certain: "Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth!" Jesus, as God the Son, brings divine rule to earth with His return.

When Jesus celebrated the Last Supper with His disciples and instituted

the Lord's Supper under the New Covenant, He sang a hymn with them. "And when they had sung an hymn, they went out into the mount of Olives" (Matt 26:30). This hymn was one of the so-called *Hallel* Psalms: the hallelujah Psalms from 113—118. For example, Psalm 116:13 reads, "I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD."

In this context, the Lord announces, "But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom" (Matt 26:29).

With these phrases, the disciples gain the assurance that He will return to establish His kingdom. In the meantime, the church doesn't sound a single hallelujah (there isn't one to be found in any of the Apostles' letters). Only in Revelation—the final book of the Bible, which announces His rule over Israel—is the hallelujah sung again.

Just as the English king and all his attendants rose from their seats at the premiere of Handel's great "Hallelujah Chorus," it will also be at the Great Hallelujah at the end of redemptive history, when the Lord establishes His rule. The whole world will rise.

"Kings of the earth, and all people; princes, and all judges of the earth:

Both young men, and maidens; old men, and children: Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his glory is above the earth and heaven. He also exalteth the horn of his people, the praise of all his saints; even of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye the LORD" (Psalm 148:11-14).

The Church Age, which exists between the Last Supper and His return, is bridged. Now the Lord will again drink of the fruit of the vine, because the marriage of the Lamb is taking place.

"And in this mountain [Zion] shall the LORD of hosts make unto all people a feast of fat things, a feast of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, of wines on the lees well refined. And he will destroy in this mountain the face of the covering cast over all people, and the vail that is spread over all nations. He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD hath spoken it. And it shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our God; we have waited for him, and he will save us: this is the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation" (Is 25:6-9). Answer: You are right: "anything goes" has become popular in the churches to a certain extent. That, however, is clearly prophesied in Scripture. At the end of his life, Paul writes: "For I know this, that after my departing shall grievous wolves enter in among you, not sparing the flock" (Acts 20:29). Second Peter 2:1 speaks of false teachers and damnable heresies, and in chapter 3, verses 3-4, he makes crystal clear what is to come.

However, when Paul writes to the Philippians, we read in chapter 1, verse 18: "What then? notwithstanding, every way, whether in pretence, or in truth, Christ is preached; and I therein do rejoice, yea, and will rejoice."



Of course, "belief" is the key to salvation. Why? Because Adam and Eve did not believe God, but believed the serpent. Therefore, the way back to God is through belief in Jesus Christ: "He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him" (John 3:36). True belief results in the rebirth; that is the work of God and cannot perish.

Satan is the influence behind the government—that's obvious. Jesus is the Head of the church, not the government. They don't get to make rules for the church.



FRIENDSHIP



I often receive encouraging letters from readers, tokens of friendship. Someone wrote, "A friendship is worth more than gold and silver. It warms the heart and helps overcome many disappointments." I agree.


here's an even more moving phrase in Proverbs 18:24: "A man that hath friends must show himself friendly: and there is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother." Several passages of Scripture show us just how deep friendship can be. The relationship between Jonathan and David is illustrative of this, as well as prophetic: "And it came to pass, when he had made an end of speaking unto Saul, that the soul of Jonathan was knit with the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul [...] Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he loved him as his own soul. And Jonathan stripped himself of the robe that was upon him, and gave it to David, and his garments, even to his sword, and to his bow, and to his girdle" (1 Sam 18:1, 3-4). If human friendship can be so profound,

how much more meaningful must friendship with our Lord Jesus Christ be! Jesus says in John 15:14-15, "Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you."

Our Lord didn't leave us in the dark on this, but revealed the full counsel of God to us through His Word. As we learn through Paul, He has even entrusted us with secrets: "Behold, I show you a mystery..." (1 Cor 15:51; cf. Rom 11:25; 1 Cor 4:1). This kind of familiarity is only possible between true friends. Under the Old Covenant, there were only a few people the Lord could deal with intimately, such as Moses: "And the LORD spake unto

Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend..." (Ex 33:11ff.). We find a similarly intimate relationship between God and Abraham: "And the LORD said, Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do?" (Gen 18:17). God calls Abraham "my friend" in Isaiah 41:8. And in James 2:23 it says, "Abraham...was called the Friend of God."


Under the New Covenant, Jesus wants to cultivate an equally affectionate friendship with us. He calls us "friends." He even called Judas, who was about to betray Him, "Friend" (cf. Matt 26:50).

Jonathan's act toward David prophetically foreshadows what Jesus gave to us. Jonathan took off his robe and gave it to David; Jesus allowed Himself to be disrobed (Matt 27:28), and in doing so, clothed us "with the robe of righteousness" (Isa 61:10). In an astonishing way, the other things that Jonathan gave out of love also

symbolize the things that are available to us as children of God and friends of Jesus. Read over Ephesians 6:11ff., where the armor of God is mentioned, with this in mind.

How are we to handle this precious friendship from our Lord? Friendship can never be one-sided! Jesus gives us a very important hint: "...if ye do whatsoever I command you." How are we doing in this regard? Or, to put it another way, have we also put on the girdle that Jonathan gave David, and that Jesus gave to us? He gave it with something very specific in mind: "Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth..." (Eph 6:14). Are we living in the light, and are we walking in the truth? Jesus Himself urges us, "Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning; And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord..." (Luke 12:35-36). That is friendship with Jesus. MC


